Number of pupils and teachers in Malaysia






Phase Education In Malaysia







RM38.7 billion

500 million to improve the teaching skills of teachers in core subject that is the national language, English, Science and Mathematics.

1.2 billion for the purpose of pre-school education.

50 million to train 3,200 Indian students in ILP and colleges under the National Dual Training Scheme.

1 billion for the Special Fund for Construction, Improvement and Maintenance School.

380 million for preschool teacher placement.

366 million for upgrading and purchasing tool for ILP and the IKBN

200 million for the Graduate employability Taskforce.

10 thousand grant to launch Center provider of Early Childhood Education (ECCE).


440 million to the Skills Development Fund.

The main focus of education Malaysia

- Investment in education was the main focus government to develop human capital, talented, creative and innovative
- RM38.7 billion allocated this year to implement various development programs in education
- According to the Economic Report 2012/2013 issued by the Ministry of Finance, of RM4.6 billion is allocated for school infrastructure involves all levels of schools (SK SJKT SJKTC)
- Abolition of school fees and the cost of government funding in school insurans pelajar premium to 5.3 million students across the country. ?
- The report also says the government launched the Malaysia Education Development Plan 2013/2025 based on 11 priority areas for high impact areas without changing the education system among teachers, school leaders, school quality, mastery of multiple languages, the role of parents and the community, the effectiveness of the resources and information sharing and the structure of the Ministry Education.
- The Government encourages the private sector to undertake a structured program of practical training to students to improve their knowledge and skills before entering the job market. (Tax incentives)
