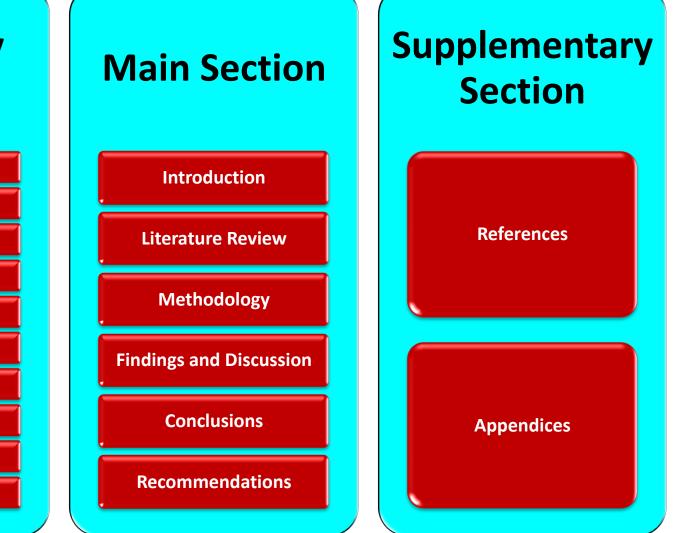




contains numbered sections with headings


contains descriptions of investigations carried out, a statement of facts discovered, clear arguments and opinions arising from the investigations and the facts uncovered by these investigations

accompanied by illustrations to make numerical or descriptive information easier to understand and remember












Figure & Table Number
