HISTORY OF GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING IN **MALAYSIA**





Vocational Guidance

- Started by group of volunteers.
- In the 1960's
 - Guidance service was started due to variety of streams.
 - ✓ Focused more on the activities regarding occupations rather than personality relationship activities.
- In the 1962-63
 - ✓ The importance of guidance in schools was agreed by UNESCO.
 - ✓ The Plan of Colombo was launched and R.K Mackenzie from Canada was the Consultant Officer (Minister of Education).



- In the 1963
 - ✓ 2 brochures were published by 11 organizers:
 - i. Guidance services in School (DBP, 1966)
 - ii. Guidance services in School (1968)
- In the 1968
 - Ministry of Education selected its Guidance Unit.
- In the 1969
 - ✓ UNICEF organized a six day course and 275 teachers were involved.
 - ✓ Ministry of Education carried out a 3 day seminar in Selangor, Kedah and Penang.



In the 1970's

- ✓ A seminar on the guidance of lesson and carrier was carried out at Sekolah Menengah Bukit Bintang, Petaling Jaya.
- ✓ The K.P 5209/35 (4) Circular suggested that every secondary and primary school should have a guiding teacher.

• In the 1973


- ✓ The Unit of Guidance and Career were applied in schools.
- ✓ The 3/67- Amendment Circular suggested every secondary school to be supplied by a career guiding teacher by the year 1983.

In the 1975

- ✓ Plan of Colombo
- ✓ RM 9,970 was subsidized for courses, seminars and brochures.



- In the 1980's
 - ✓ Guidance and Counseling course was carried out in Special Education Teacher's College for a year.



- In the 1981/82
 - ✓ University Putra Malaysia offered Degree of Guidance and Counseling course and it was a four year course.
 - ✓ Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia offered the same program but at the level of Diploma.
